Cromer Community Association (CIO) (Charitable Incorporated Organisation) is a charitable body whose primary purpose is to manage and let Cromer Community Centre, which is situated in Garden Street, Cromer, NR27 9HN. It is run by trustees, with the objective to provide a facility for use by the people of Cromer and its environs to advance education and to provide facilities in the interests of social welfare, recreation and leisure time activities.

The hall was opened in 1957 as a facility for the Cromer Women's Institute, in December 2023 the freehold was transferred to Cromer Community Association (CIO) to secure the long term future as a valuable community facility.

The Community Centre hosts a number of groups who make use of its facilities three fitness clubs, local interest groups, recreational facilities and a record fair.

The Trustees are continuing to modernise the Centre and have already undertaken work with the funding under 'LEADER', a 'bottom-up' approach. This funding was from the European Agricultural Fund for Rural Development (EAFRD) delivered via Defra.

The work included Rebuilding and extension of entrance hall to improve disabled access and increase the storage area for mobility vehicles and push-chairs, installation for the first time of a

gentlemens' lavatory and refurbishment of ladies' and disabled lavatory and upgrade of the kitchen facilities plus the installation of a serving hatch.

Work to improve the centre will continue as funds permit, including methods to reduce the energy bills which have risen in recent years from £2.1k to £4.6k.

Since the start of the Energy crisis in 2021 trustees have been running a well-attended Warm Space every Wednesday and Friday mornings from 10am to 12.30pm.

In 1983 West Runton Pavilion closed and was demolished leaving North Norfolk short of live music venues.

Cromer Community Association has now stepped into this void and created an entertainment programme offering live music and comedy. The principle is to bring well known artists to Cromer with sensible ticket prices, affordable drinks and a great night out for everyone, without having to travel miles.

Cromer Community Association is selffinancing and all the money raised goes back into the community centre funds, with trustees putting their time and effort in for free. Any staff employed or people doing work for Cromer Community Association are paid at least the real living wage as set out by the Living wage Foundation. Our grateful thanks go to:
